



Spring 2022 Early Enrollment Opportunity

About:

- BridgeValley Community & Technical College (BVCTC) is offering an Art Appreciation (ARTS 120) course to high school and home school students (minimum age 16 before the first day of class) at a reduced cost of \$25 per credit hour. Taking advantage of this course will have a total tuition cost of \$75.
- The textbook for this class is \$100.
- The course is listed on the West Virginia Core Transfer agreement.
- The class will be web-based and asynchronous in delivery. There will be firm due dates for all course components, but there is not a specific day/time for the class to meet as a group.
- ARTS 120 begins on January 24, 2022 and ends on May 13, 2022 (including the final exam period).
- Space is limited. Application begins on October 26.
- Please note that all students will be required to successfully complete STOR 099, our college and online learning orientation class prior to the first day of ARTS 120. There is no cost for the STOR 099 and it is non-credit.

Course Description ARTS 120:

This course is intended to be a first level introductory art course for the beginning art student, as well as the student seeking humanities elective in the visual arts. The student's appreciation of art will be developed through aesthetics, disciplines, critical evaluations, projects, history and attendance at a real or virtual art show.

There is no testing prerequisite for this offering.





Admission & Enrollment Process

 - 3. Meet with Mr. Jeff Martin on the day and time you have scheduled with him either in person or via remote options.
 - 4. At your appointment with Mr. Martin you will complete all necessary forms and documents:
 - o Complete the supplemental early enrollment form and registration paperwork. Your parent or legal guardian will need to be present.
 - o FERPA form
 - o Complete the registration form for STOR 099, ARTS 120
 - 5. Complete STOR 099 and send the certificate of completion to Mr. Martin prior to the first day of class. This must be completed before you may take ARTS 120.
